

Breast Cancer Took my Sisters Life

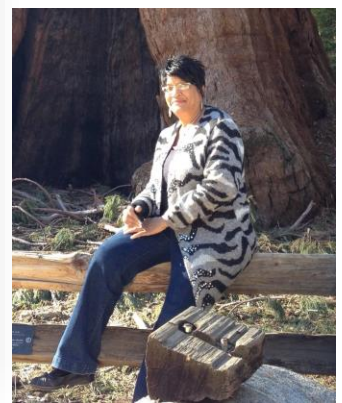

Feb 13, 2019 - U.S. Breast Cancer Statistics. About 1 in 8 U.S. women (about 12%) will develop invasive breast cancer over the course of her lifetime. In 2019, an estimated 268,600 new cases of invasive breast cancer are expected to be diagnosed in women in the U.S., along with 62,930 new cases of non-invasive Breast Cancer. States with the highest breast cancer rates during that period were Connecticut; Washington, D.C.; Massachusetts; and Hawaii. On the flip side, the state with the lowest breast cancer rate is Nevada, with an annual average of 109 per 100,000 women diagnosed during that period. Nov 2, 2018
